Pursuant to sections 330 and 331 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”), and Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (collectively, the “Bankruptcy Rules”), Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones LLP (“PSZ&J” or the “Firm”), Co-Counsel for the Debtors and Debtors in Possession (“Debtors”), hereby submits its First and Final Application for Compensation and for Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period from March 25, 2018 through May 15, 2018 (the “Application”).

By this Application PSZ&J seeks a final allowance of compensation in the amount of \$214,678.00 and actual and necessary expenses in the amount of \$37,038.12 for a

total allowance of \$251,716.12 and payment of the unpaid portion of such fees and expenses for the period March 25, 2018 through May 15, 2018 (the “Fee Period”).

Background

1. On March 25, 2018, Debtors commenced their cases by filing voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Debtors continued in possession of their properties and continued to operate and manage their businesses as debtors in possession pursuant to sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. No trustee or examiner has been appointed in any of the Debtors’ chapter 11 cases.

2. The Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2).

3. The retention of PSZ&J, as Co-Counsel for the Debtors, was approved effective as of March 25, 2018 by this Court’s “Order Pursuant to Section 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, Rule 2014 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and Local Rule 2014-1 Authorizing the Employment and Retention of Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones LLP as Co-Counsel for the Debtors and Debtors in Possession *Nunc Pro Tunc* to Petition Date,” signed on or about April 13, 2018 (the “Retention Order”). The Retention Order authorized PSZ&J to be compensated on an hourly basis and to be reimbursed for actual and necessary out-of-pocket expenses.

4. Attorneys retained pursuant to sections 327 or 1103 of the Bankruptcy Code must comply with certain requirements of the United States Trustee’s Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed under 11

U.S.C. §330 by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases (the “Revised UST Guidelines”). The Office of the United States Trustee has promulgated forms to aid in compliance with the Revised UST Guidelines. Charts and tables based on such forms are attached hereto as exhibits and filled out with data to the extent relevant to these cases: Exhibit “A”, Customary and Comparable Compensation Disclosures with Fee Applications; Exhibit “B”, Summary of Timekeepers Included in this Fee Application, Exhibit “C-1”, Budget; Exhibit “C-2”, Staffing Plan; Exhibit “D-1”, Summary of Compensation Requested by Project Category; Exhibit “D-2”, Summary of Expense Reimbursement Requested by Category; and Exhibit “E”, Summary Cover Sheet of Fee Application.

**PSZ&J’s APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION AND
FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES**

5. By this Final Fee Application, PSZ&J requests that the Court approve the final allowance of compensation for professional services rendered and the reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses incurred by PSZ&J from March 25, 2018 through May 15, 2018. To the extent that PSZ&J has incurred fees and expenses in addition to the foregoing, PSZ&J reserves the right, and respectfully requests that the Court authorize PSZ&J, to file a supplemental fee application(s) and submit a certificate of no objection and order to the Court for final approval of such fees and expenses as may be reflected in any supplemental fee application.

6. At all relevant times, PSZ&J has been a disinterested person as that term is defined in §101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code and has not represented or held an interest adverse to the interest of the Debtors.

7. All services for which compensation is requested by PSZ&J were performed for or on behalf of the Debtors and not on behalf of any committee, creditor or other person.

8. PSZ&J has received no payment and no promises for payment from any source other than from the Debtors for services rendered or to be rendered in any capacity whatsoever in connection with the matters covered by this Application. There is no agreement or understanding between PSZ&J and any other person other than the partners of PSZ&J for the sharing of compensation to be received for services rendered in these cases. PSZ&J has received payments from the Debtors during the year prior to the Petition Date in the amount of \$215,453.00 in connection with the preparation of initial documents and the prepetition representation of the Debtors. Upon final reconciliation of the amount actually expended prepetition, any balance remaining from the payments to PSZ&J was credited to the Debtors and utilized as PSZ&J's retainer to apply to postpetition fees and expenses pursuant to the compensation procedures approved by this Court in accordance with the Bankruptcy Code.

9. The professional services and related expenses for which PSZ&J requests final allowance of compensation and reimbursement of expenses were rendered and incurred in connection with this case in the discharge of PSZ&J's professional responsibilities as attorneys for the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases. PSZ&J's services have been necessary and beneficial to the Debtors and their estates, creditors and other parties in interest.

Fee Statements

10. The fee statements for the Fee Period are attached hereto as Exhibit F.

These statements contain daily time logs describing the time spent by each attorney and paraprofessional during the Fee Period. To the best of PSZ&J's knowledge, this Application complies with sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code and the Bankruptcy Rules. PSZ&J's time reports are initially handwritten by the attorney or paralegal performing the described services. The time reports are organized on a daily basis. PSZ&J is particularly sensitive to issues of "lumping" and, unless time was spent in one time frame on a variety of different matters for a particular client, separate time entries are set forth in the time reports. PSZ&J's charges for its professional services are based upon the time, nature, extent and value of such services and the cost of comparable services other than in a case under the Bankruptcy Code. PSZ&J has reduced its charges related to any non-working "travel time" to fifty percent (50%) of PSZ&J's standard hourly rate. To the extent it is feasible, PSZ&J professionals attempt to work during travel.

Actual and Necessary Expenses

11. A summary of actual and necessary expenses incurred by PSZ&J for the Fee Period is attached hereto as part of Exhibit F. PSZ&J customarily charges \$0.10 per page for photocopying expenses related to cases, such as these, arising in Delaware. PSZ&J's photocopying machines automatically record the number of copies made when the person that is doing the copying enters the client's account number into a device attached to the photocopier. PSZ&J summarizes each client's photocopying charges on a daily basis.

12. PSZ&J charges \$.25 per page for out-going facsimile transmissions.

There is no additional charge for long distance telephone calls on faxes. The charge for outgoing facsimile transmissions reflects PSZ&J's calculation of the actual costs incurred by PSZ&J for the machines, supplies and extra labor expenses associated with sending telecopies and is reasonable in relation to the amount charged by outside vendors who provide similar services. PSZ&J does not charge the Debtors for the receipt of faxes in these cases.

13. With respect to providers of on-line legal research services (e.g., LEXIS and WESTLAW), PSZ&J charges the standard usage rates these providers charge for computerized legal research. PSZ&J bills its clients the actual amounts charged by such services, with no premium. Any volume discount received by PSZ&J is passed on to the client.

14. PSZ&J believes the foregoing rates are the market rates that the majority of law firms charge clients for such services. In addition, PSZ&J believes that such charges are in accordance with the American Bar Association's ("ABA") guidelines, as set forth in the ABA's Statement of Principles, dated January 12, 1995, regarding billing for disbursements and other charges.

Summary of Services Rendered

15. The names of the partners and associates of PSZ&J who have rendered professional services in these cases during the Fee Period, and the paralegals and case management assistants of PSZ&J who provided services to these attorneys during the Fee Period, are set forth in the attached Exhibit F.

16. PSZ&J, by and through such persons, has prepared and assisted in the preparation of various motions and orders submitted to the Court for consideration, advised the Debtors on a regular basis with respect to various matters in connection with the Debtors' bankruptcy cases, and performed all necessary professional services which are described and narrated in detail below. PSZ&J's efforts have been extensive due to the size and complexity of the Debtors' bankruptcy cases.

Summary of Services by Project

17. The services rendered by PSZ&J during the Fee Period can be grouped into the categories set forth below. PSZ&J attempted to place the services provided in the category that best relates to such services. However, because certain services may relate to one or more categories, services pertaining to one category may in fact be included in another category. These services performed, by categories, are generally described below, with a more detailed identification of the actual services provided set forth on the attached Exhibit F. Exhibit F identifies the attorneys and paraprofessionals who rendered services relating to each category, along with the number of hours for each individual and the total compensation sought for each category.

A. Bankruptcy Litigation

18. This category relates to work regarding motions or adversary proceedings in the Bankruptcy Court. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things: (1) performed work regarding First Day Motions and Orders; (2) performed work regarding Agenda Notices and Hearing Binders; (3) performed work regarding negotiations; (4) reviewed and analyzed the

United States Trustee comments regarding First Day Motions and performed work regarding a response; (5) attended to notice issues; (6) performed work regarding *pro hac vice* motions; (7) prepared for and attended a hearing on March 27, 2018 regarding First Day Motions; (8) attended to scheduling issues; (9) performed work regarding Second Day Motions and Orders; (10) performed research; (11) reviewed and analyzed issues regarding motions to disband committees appointed by the United States Trustee; (12) attended to deadline issues; (13) prepared for and attended a hearing on May 2, 2018; (14) attended to case closing issues; and (15) conferred and corresponded regarding litigation issues.

Fees: \$82,536.50; Hours: 128.30

B. Case Administration

19. This category relates to work regarding administration of these cases. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things: (1) maintained a memorandum of critical dates; (2) maintained document control; (3) corresponded regarding case administration issues; and; (4) maintained service lists.

Fees: \$3,459.50; Hours: 10.90

C. Claims Administration and Objections

20. This category relates to work regarding claims administration and claims objections. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things: (1) performed work regarding a motion and order to authorize the payment of certain pre-petition claims; (2) performed work regarding a customer program motion and order; (3) responded to creditor inquiries; and (4) conferred regarding claim issues.

Fees: \$11,974.50; Hours: 13.10

D. Employee Benefits and Pensions

21. This category relates to work regarding employee benefits and pension plans. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things, performed work regarding a wage motion and order.

Fees: \$262.50; Hours: 0.70

E. Financial Filings

22. This category relates to work regarding compliance with reporting requirements. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things: (1) performed work regarding Initial Debtor Interview (“IDI”) documents; (2) prepared for and attended the IDI; (3) performed work regarding Monthly Operating Reports; (4) attended to United States Trustee fee issues; and (5) corresponded and conferred regarding financial filings issues.

Fees: \$13,632.50; Hours: 19.10

F. Financing

23. This category relates to work regarding Debtor in Possession (“DIP”) financing and use of cash collateral. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things: (1) reviewed and analyzed DIP financing issues; (2) performed work regarding a notice of hearing on DIP financing; (3) performed work regarding an interim DIP financing order; (4) performed work regarding a cash management motion and interim and final cash management orders; (5) performed work regarding a motion to seal DIP financing fee letters; (6) performed work regarding a seal order; (7) performed work regarding budget issues; (8) performed research; (9) performed work regarding a response to objections to final DIP

financing order; (10) performed work regarding a final DIP financing order; and (11) corresponded and conferred regarding financing issues.

Fees: \$20,459.00; Hours: 28.20

G. General Business Advice

24. The category relates to issues regarding general business matters and advice. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things, reviewed and analyzed a certificate of incorporation, bylaws and a stockholders agreement.

Fees: \$8,287.50; Hours: 8.50

H. Meeting of Creditors

25. The category relates to work regarding meeting of creditors issues. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things, reviewed and analyzed Committee formation issues.

Fees: \$687.00; Hours: 0.60

I. Operations

26. The category relates to operations issues. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things, performed work regarding a utility motion and order.

Fees: \$610.00; Hours: 1.20

J. Plan and Disclosure Statement

27. This category relates to work regarding a Plan of Reorganization ("Plan") and Disclosure Statement. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things: (1) performed work regarding notice of Disclosure Statement and confirmation hearing; (2) performed work regarding a scheduling order; (3) reviewed and analyzed a Plan and Disclosure Statement;

(4) performed research; (5) performed work regarding a Plan supplement; (6) reviewed and analyzed feasibility issues; (7) performed work regarding an agreed order resolving Cerberus objection; (8) reviewed and analyzed objections to Plan confirmation and performed work regarding a resolution of objections; (9) reviewed and analyzed exculpation and release issues; (10) performed work regarding Agenda Notices; (11) performed work regarding a brief and declarations in support of confirmation; (12) performed work regarding a confirmation order; (13) prepared for and attended a confirmation hearing on May 2, 2018; (14) attended to Effective Date issues; and (15) corresponded and conferred regarding Plan and Disclosure Statement issues.

Fees: \$45,396.50; Hours: 63.70

K. Retention of Professionals

28. This category relates to issues regarding retention of the Firm. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things, performed work regarding its retention application and order, and regarding a supplemental declaration in support of retention.

Fees: \$4,803.50; Hours: 6.70

L. Retention of Professionals--Others

29. This category relates to issues regarding retention of professionals, other than the Firm. During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things: (1) performed work regarding Ordinary Course Professionals; (2) performed work regarding the A&M, Prime Clerk, Lazard, Milbank, Lowenstein, Deloitte, and Grant Thornton matters; (3) reviewed and analyzed,

and responded to, comments of the United States Trustee regarding retention issues;

(4) performed research; and (5) corresponded and conferred regarding retention issues.

Fees: \$20,681.50; Hours: 35.70

M. Stay Litigation

30. This category relates to the automatic stay and relief from stay motions.

During the Fee Period, the Firm, among other things, performed work regarding the Cerberus matter.



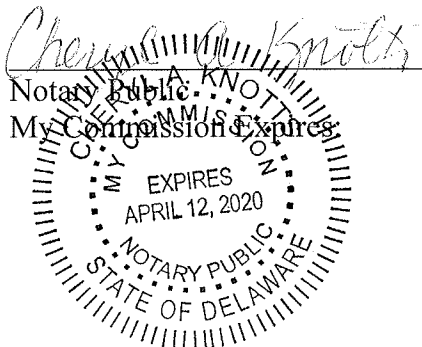

**ORDER GRANTING
FIRST AND FINAL APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION
AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES OF
PACHULSKI STANG ZIEHL & JONES LLP, AS CO-COUNSEL
FOR THE DEBTORS AND DEBTORS IN POSSESSION, FOR

Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones LLP (“PSZ&J”), as Co-Counsel for the Debtors and Debtors in Possession (“Debtors”) in the above-captioned cases, filed its First and Final Application for Compensation and for Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period from March 25, 2018 through May 15, 2018 (the “Final Application”). The Court has reviewed the Final Application and finds that: (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (b) notice of the Final Application, and any hearing on the Final Application, was adequate under the circumstances; and (c) all persons with standing have been afforded the opportunity to be heard on the Final Application. Accordingly, it is hereby
